Competition Format:

The format will depend on the number of teams that enter. An Open Division team shall be comprised of 10-12 players from the same high school. The team's coach/captain will order their players to position one through ten for singles and select pairs of players to compete in doubles positions one through five, for a total of fifteen matches. If the number of teams allows for it, teams will participate in preliminary round-robin groups of three or four teams. Teams that place first or second in each preliminary round-robin group will advance to the Championship bracket; Teams that place third or fourth in each preliminary round-robin group will advance to a Consolation bracket. The Championship and Consolation brackets will be single elimination. If more than 20 teams enter, we will use a single-elimination format from the start and Teams that lose in the first round will compete in a consolation bracket.

The Girls Division will have teams comprised of 2-4 players and use a Davis Cup format; two singles matches, a doubles match, and two singles matches. Girls must choose to compete in either the Girl's Division or the Open Division and cannot compete in both.

Matches will be best two out of three games in the preliminary round-robins and in the Championship and Consolation brackets.

Awards:

Trophies for display at school will be awarded to the teams that win first, second, and third place in the Championship bracket. Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals will be awarded to all members of the first, second, and third place teams. The winner of the Consolation bracket will also receive a trophy.
